Workshops!


- We have weekly workshops *almost* every Tuesday @ 7pm in the ILC

- We'll announce when we play these in Discord and playing them alongside others is the best way to learn!






Training Platform








UMass CTF

The CyberSec Room - LGRT 212


- Awesome place to mess with cool hardware
