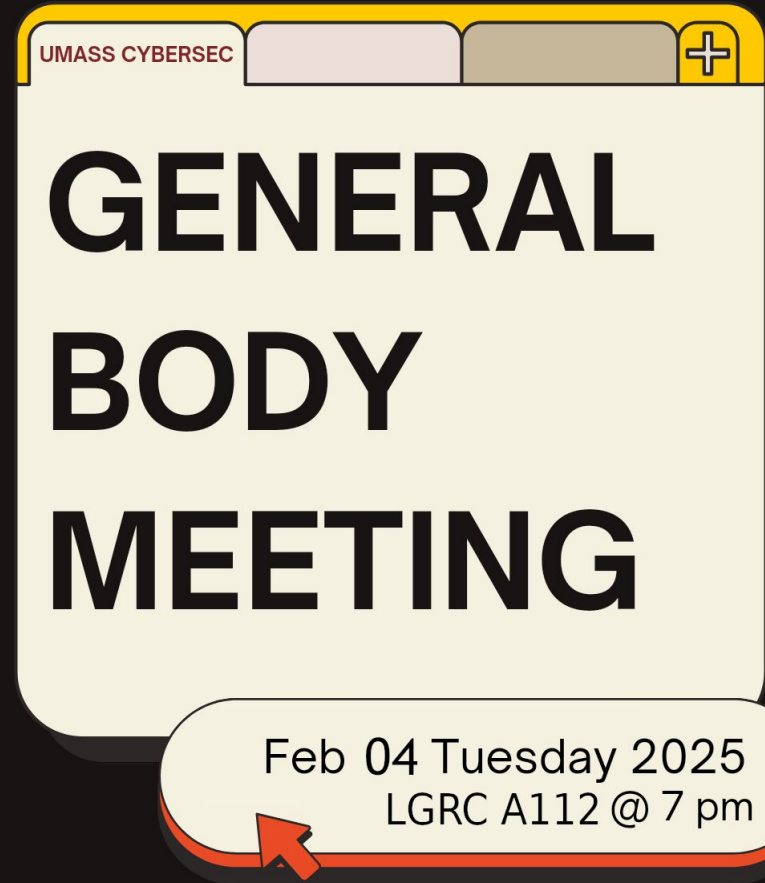

Collegiate Cyber Defense Competition (CCDC)

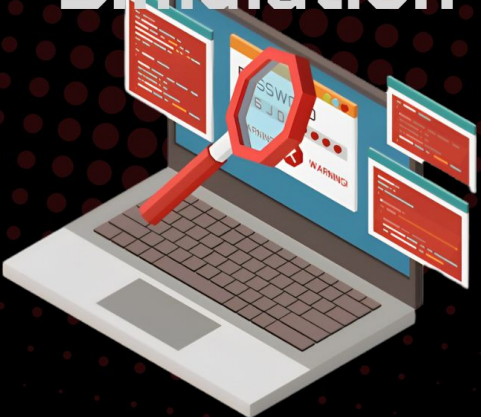
- Competition we compete in every Spring semester
